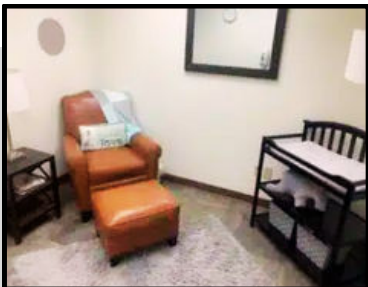
### Trainings, Programs & Outreach

### Accommodation Process

1. The student registers with the OAS;
2. The student takes part in the interactive process with OAS;
3. The student submits supporting documentation; and
4. OAS conducts an accommodation request analysis

**The entire accommodation approval process should be completed a minimum of 2-3 weeks before the accommodation is needed.**
