- Dartboards
- Devices that interfere and/or extend wireless networks
- Electrical fryers/frying pans
- Electric heaters
- Electric saucepans
- Electric Scooters/Hover Boards/Motorized Vehicles in Buildings
- Electric skillets
- Grills
- Halogen lamps

- High wattage spot/flood lights
- Hot plates
- Incenses and/or burners
- Instapot/pressure cookers
- Lava lamps
- Microwave ovens
- Nails/tacks
- Oil lamps
- Portable dishwashers
- Potpourri burners
- Power tools
- Splat guns
- Sun lamps
- Toasters
- Tobacco smoking apparatuses (Hookahs, pipes, electronic cigarettes, vape devices, etc.)
- Wax heaters, including Scentsy-type wax heaters
