PERFORMING ARTS

CHOIRS

University Choir meets TR 3:30-4:45pm to rehearse choral repertoire in a variety of styles. Gospel Choir meets Thursdays 5-6:15pm and works with a full band.

MARCHING & CONCERT BANDS

Marching Band meets MWF 3:30-5:30pm & plays at home football games. Concert Band begins after football season & meets MW 3:30-5:00pm.

ROCK LAB

Students in Rock Lab perform and record together in various genres on keys, guitar, bass and drums. Meets one weekday evening at 6pm.

SELECT ENSEMBLES

Auditions are held during the first week of fall semester. Ensembles may include: songwriting collectives, a cappella/vocal harmony groups & other bands in the styles of funk, jazz, hip hop, rock, metal, country & more. Most ensembles meet 1-3 hours/week. Touring ensembles meet 3-5 hours/week & perform regularly off campus. Students in Select Ensembles also participate in one of the large ensembles above.

COLOR GUARD (FLAGS)

Meets MWF 3:30-5:30pm and performs with the Marching Band at home football games.

DANCE TEAM

The TU Dance Team practices MWF 6-7:30am and TR 2:00-3:15 to refine techniques in jazz, lyrical and hip hop. The Dance Team performs at halftime during home football and basketball games, and prepares a showcase in the spring semester.

THEATRE ARTS

TU produces 1 or 2 productions each year. Cast spends 2-5 hours per week in rehearsal. In the 2 weeks preceding the production, cast & crew spends 3-4 hours each evening. Auditioning is not required, though each student must contribute at least 6 hours per semester.

To audition for any of the above,

- Prepare two 1-minute selections of your choice that best demonstrate your experience and interests

MEDIA & VISUAL ARTS

ART TEAM

Students on the Art Team work individually and as a group to create unique and innovative projects in a variety of mediums. Art Team meets Tuesdays 3:30-6:30pm.

MEDIA PRODUCTION TEAM

The Media Production Team works individually and as a group to create video production, photography and design projects and other media work. Meets 5-6pm Tuesdays.

BROADCAST TEAM

The Broadcast Team gives students real-world experience providing on-air and behind-the-scenes support and content creation for the 24 intercollegiate teams in TU's NCAA Division II athletic program. Student spends 3-6 hours per week on broadcast, production or content creation work.

CONCERT PRODUCTION TEAM

The Concert Production Team assists with set up, stage crew, live sound, photography, video, and lighting at each TiffinArts performance. Meets Thursdays 5-6pm.

DIGITAL NEWSPAPER

The Blaze is TU's student-led newspaper. Students meet once a week and work individually on articles, media and planning.

TIFFINMUSIC STUDIOS

TiffinMusic Studios is TU's record label and production house. In addition to scheduled recording sessions, TMS meets once weekly.
