- **Credits earned can transfer toward a bachelor's or associate's degree**

- Submit application at [www.tiffin.edu/ccp](http://www.tiffin.edu/ccp)
- Request high school transcript to be sent to TU
- Complete the Mature Permissions Slip
- Complete Assessment Exam if necessary
- **Course Selection and Registration**
  - Review schedule offering and Level I course list
  - Complete a course selection sheet
  - Submit the completed sheet to **both** your high school counselor and [ccp@tiffin.edu](mailto:ccp@tiffin.edu)
